binder* 1 ½ inch (Bigger is not better because it will not fit in the desk.)
3 plastic folders with pockets and three hole prongs or rings in the middle*
1 package of tab dividers
2 packs regular-lined notebook paper
1 two-subject spiral*
1 "Composition Book"* (hardbound with a staple, not spiral bound)
Pencil zipper bag for three-ring binder* (needed for math and other classes)
#2 pencils – NO MECHANICALS, PLEASE
2 red ink pens, 2 black or blue pens
erasers
3x5 index cards
protractor
Five Star Flex College Ruled Refillable Notebook - 1 subject, 80 sheets, compact size (math)
2 packages of glue sticks*
dictionary* (Recommended: Webster's New World Dictionary)
1" binder* (science)
1" binder* (Latin)
1"x8"x9" Binder for Bible cards (students may use theirs from the previous year or order one from school)
2 copy paper

Art Supplies* Needed: colored pencils, markers (8-pack of Crayola), scissors, ruler, Elmer's glue, black Sharpie markers (1 fine and 1 ultra-fine), watercolors (in tray, not tubes), 2 glue sticks (will need to be replenished after Christmas break), oil pastels, personal paintbrushes (optional), package of cardstock. Art supplies need to be stored in some sort of box. A photo storage box works well and stacks nicely in the classroom.
